Re: ATM Signage Bill Introduced in Senate

This afternoon EFTA received confirmation from the office of Sen. Mike Johanns (R-NE) that he has introduced companion legislation to H.R. 4367 that seeks to eliminate the dual fee notification requirement at an ATM. At this writing, the bill has not yet been assigned a number. Senators Mark Warner (D-VA), Jon Tester (D-MT) and Bob Corker (R-TN) joined Johanns as original co-sponsors. All serve on the Senate Banking Committee where the bill will most likely be referred.

As you may know, Kurt Helwig and I met with staff for Senators Johanns and Warner this week as well as the staff of Senators Tester and Corker last year. Yesterday, Kurt, Bob Bucceri and I also met with the staff for the House sponsor, Rep. Luetkemeyer (R-MO) and the staff of House Financial Services Committee.

Rep. Luetkemeyer continues to add to the growing list of bipartisan co-sponsors to H.R. 4367. His office confirmed today that Financial Institutions Subcommittee Chair Shelley Moore Capito (R-WV) has agreed to co-sponsor H.R. 4367.
